Overview for Pasco and Hernando Counties (August 2020)

**Our Mission:** Pasco-Hernando Workforce Board enhances economic development efforts of our region by providing a well-trained, high-quality workforce which supports the success of local business and improves the quality of life.

Employer Services

- **Pasco Hernando** employers directly listed **990 new jobs**, which is a **125%** increase over last year.
- The **CareerSource Pasco Hernando** One Stops hosted **0** employer recruitments (100% decrease) with **0** applicants in attendance.
- A total of **\$20,162.50** was spent on **13** customers being trained (57% increase) through the **Employed Worker Training (EWT)** and **On the Job Training (OJT)** programs.

Job Seekers

- **349 people** (a **48%** decrease) were assisted in finding employment.
- **1,189** people visited a **One-Stop** career center in Pasco and Hernando Counties. This is a **82%** decrease from last year due to COVID-19.
- **33** Pasco Hernando **Veterans** found **employment**. This is a **38%** decrease over last year.
- The Mobile One Stop brought services to **0** job seekers in remote locations throughout **Pasco and Hernando due to COVID 19**.
- **71** members attended (24% decrease) a monthly **Professional Placement Network (PPN)** meeting in **Pasco and Hernando** counties.

Workforce Training

- PHWB provided **Individual Training Accounts** for **32** low-income adults and dislocated workers (**78% increase**) in **Pasco and Hernando counties**.
- Through **August 31, 2020** PHWB, assisted **140** customers (**40% increase**) referred from Department of Children and Family Services for the **Welfare Transition Program** find employment.

Youth

- **14 youth** (**46% decrease**) participating in the Youth program in **Pasco and Hernando** counties found employment or enrolled in post-secondary education.
- Since July 1, 2020, **Pasco Hernando** has had **13** youth earn a credential (46% decrease). 4 youth (300% increase) have completed their internship opportunities.

Sector Strategy

- Since **July 1, 2020**, PHWB enrolled **27** candidates in one of the seven-sector strategy fields' Healthcare, Manufacturing, Construction, Retail, Transportation/Warehouse, Finance, and Info Technology. A 80% increase over last year
- Through **August 31, 2020**, a total of **27** (13% decrease) candidates have gained employment in one of the seven sector fields.
