Overview for Pasco and Hernando Counties (July 2020)

Our Mission: Pasco-Hernando Workforce Board enhances economic development efforts of our region by providing a well-trained, high-quality workforce which supports the success of local business and improves the quality of life.

Employer Services

- **Pasco Hernando** employers directly listed **473 new jobs**, which is a **102%** increase over last year.
- The **CareerSource Pasco Hernando** One Stops hosted **0** employer recruitments (100% decrease) with **0** applicants in attendance.
- A total of **\$10,162.50** was spent on **11** customers being trained (83% increase) through the **Employed Worker Training (EWT)** and **On the Job Training (OJT)** programs.

Job Seekers

- **153 people** (a **58%** decrease) were assisted in finding employment.
- **568** people visited a **One-Stop** career center in Pasco and Hernando Counties. This is a **83%** decrease from last year due to COVID-19.
- **19** Pasco Hernando **Veterans** found **employment**. This is a **32%** increase over last year.
- The Mobile One Stop brought services to **0** job seekers in remote locations throughout **Pasco and Hernando due to COVID 19**.
- **44** members attended (33% decrease) a monthly **Professional Placement Network (PPN)** meeting in **Pasco and Hernando** counties.

Workforce Training

- PHWB provided **Individual Training Accounts** for **13** low-income adults and dislocated workers (**30% increase**) in **Pasco and Hernando counties**.
- Through **July 31, 2020** PHWB, assisted **68** customers (**106% increase**) referred from Department of Children and Family Services for the **Welfare Transition Program** find employment.

Youth

- **4 youth** (**69% decrease**) participating in the Youth program in **Pasco and Hernando** counties found employment or enrolled in post-secondary education.
- Since July 1, 2020, **Pasco Hernando** has had **1** youth earn a credential (83% decrease). **0** youth (same as last year) have completed their internship opportunities.

Sector Strategy

- Since **July 1, 2020**, PHWB enrolled **20** candidates in one of the seven-sector strategy fields' Healthcare, Manufacturing, Construction, Retail, Transportation/Warehouse, Finance, and Info Technology. A 100% increase over last year
- Through **July 31, 2020**, a total of **12** (45% decrease) candidates have gained employment in one of the seven sector fields.
